<sup>1</sup> Specific species orders can be requested and are welcome. Please be sure to request well enough in advance to allow for harvest in a given year.

<sup>2</sup> G0 = Generation zero - A wild collected seed source, typically from a native grassland.

G1 = Generation one - Collected from plants that are grown from Generation 0 seed. An example could be a seed production plot that was established using G0 seed.

G2 = Generation two - Collected from plants that were grown from generation one seed. An example could be commercially purchased seed from a national seed vendor.
